Congratulations to all that contributed to the success of the **Bridges Community Youth Golf Program**! We had some challenges due to the
COVID-19 restrictions in 2020 and 2021, but we are happy to say that we
were able to conduct **4 half-day clinics** for the youth of the **Boys and Girls Clubs of Winnipeg**. In addition to the kids of the Boys and Girls
Club, it was our privilege to have youth from the **Eagles Nest Indigenous Youth Program** be involved in our 4 clinics as well.

The golf academy for the younger kids (ages 5-11) is taking place this season. Clinics are scheduled for the first 2 Sundays in June from, and usually involve **80-100 children**.

Our Boys and Girls Club Programs and Eagles Nest Indigenous Youth Programs are *free of charge*. The programs are totally funded by: Bridges Men's and Ladies Golf Leagues, the businesses that donated the fantastic prizes for our Junior Program Raffle and a much-appreciated grant from Golf Manitoba. Each of you made this happen! It truly was a wonderful team effort!

RICHARDSON WEALTH MANAGEMENT JUNIOR PROGRAM

The Richardson Wealth Management Junior Program is a golf camp that runs the first 2 Sundays in June. Kids ages 5-11 participate in an hour long session. The program is open to the public and Bridges is expected to host up to 80 kids this year.

BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB PROGRAM

The Boys and Girls Club of Winnipeg selects kids and youths from 3 clubs from Winnipeg to participate in a completely free program at Bridges. The goal of the program is to give all kids a chance to golf and develop interpersonal skills and confidence through our program.

Younger Boys and Girls Club (BGC) kids (ages 5-11) also participate in the Richardson Wealth Management Junior Program free of charge. 10 BGC kids will join the Junior Program this year.

RICHARDSON WEALTH MANAGEMENT JUNIOR PROGRAM

THE PROGRAM

The Richardson Wealth Management Junior Golf Academy (started in 2010) and has involved 80 to 120 children ages 5 to 11 each year. We conduct 2 one hour clinics each of the *first 2 Sundays in June* and always have had a fantastic turnout! It's great to see the youngsters, their parents and grandparents enjoying this introduction to this wonderful game.

We also use the Richardson Wealth Management Junior Program as a way to include kids ages 5-11 from the **Boys & Girls Club** who are too young to join the 4 week sessions with the older youth from the Boys & Girls Club and the Eagles Nest Indigenous Youth Program.

BOYS & GIRLS CLUB GOLF PROGRAM



THE PROGRAM

The Boys and Girls Club Golf Program (started in 2014) was a wonderful success story here at Bridges again this past summer. We were able to conduct four weeks of **4-hour clinics** with 15 youth per session, including the **4-6 youth** who joined from the **Eagles Nest Program**. Throughout the program, we instruct the kids on the fundamentals of the golf swing, teach them the etiquette of the sport, play a couple of holes each day, and after golf, we have dinner together.

EAGLES NEST INDIGENOUS YOUTH GOLF PROGRAM

THE PROGRAM

The partnership between Bridges and the Eagles Nest Indigenous Youth Facility started in 2019, and has been one of the most rewarding programs for us. Shelly Loustel, an Eagles Nest staff member, approached us in 2019 and asked if 3 of their youth could come and hit some balls one night. We suggested that they might enjoy *joining in on the Boys & Girls Club Golf Program* at Bridges. The Boys & Girls Club staff and kids were so welcoming of the new boys, it was so tender, so compassionate and a wonderful experience for the 3 boys to be accepted into a new group of kids that year. From there the program has continued.

The Eagles Nest Youths are between the ages of 12-18 and join our Boys & Girls Club 4 week sessions. There are set to be **4-6 youth** from the Eagles Nest Program that will join us this year, and it is our goal to accommodate more Eagles Nest youth into our future programming.
